## **Ground Rules:**

- 1. No Item may be removed from the exhibit while on display during the duration of the show.
- 2. Any major misrepresentation of an item on display may disqualify the display for an award.
- 3. Items which are not original, e.g., reproduction will be so labeled to avoid disqualification.
- 4. Items on display must be the property of the named exhibitor or identified as the real owner.

**Judges:** Please judge the above-named exhibit by the following categories. Carefully consider your evaluation and then determine the number of points to be awarded in each category. You may award any number of points you wish per category, not to exceed the maximum listed. The individual Judge's points will be tabulated by either the AMCA Treasurer/Secretary or a member of the Board of Directors to determine the exhibit winners.
